Proposal 2006-07


- Raise minimum AW from 0 to /21
- No change to maximum sub-allocation size



AW History

- 1993 - recommended as /19
- 1995 - minimum of 0 and maximum of /19
- 1999 - maximum removed
- 2001 - LIR infrastructure AW introduced

LIR: Expected Impact

- Provisioning processes could be streamlined
- New staff at LIRs may need closer supervision when making assignments



RIPE NCC: Expected Impact

- Focus moves
 - from 'second opinion' requests
 - to additional allocation requests
- Additional pro-active audits
- LIRs ignoring RIPE policies may **not** qualify for another allocation
